The purpose of this Amendment is to:

- 1) Revise the Special Contract Requirements as follows:
 - a) Section 633 to clarify material requirements for permanent signs; and
 - b) Section 635 to clarify material and installation requirements for construction signs and temporary pavement markings.
- 2) Revise the Plans to add a missing detail for temporary traffic control.

Special Contract Requirement changes

1. *Delete the forth paragraph of Subsection 633.03 of the Special Contract Requirements, page J-28, and substitute the following:*

Furnish corrosion resistant steel (2"x2" weathering steel) posts for all permanent signs except the W8-4 "Soft Shoulder" signs. Furnish wood (4"x4") posts for the W8-4 "Soft Shoulder" signs.

2. *Delete the last sentence of the second paragraph of Subsection 635.07 of the FP, and substitute the following:*

Install wood, aluminum, galvanized steel, or corrosion resistant steel posts according to Section 633.

3. *Delete Subsection 635.13 of the Special Contract Requirements, page J-30, and substitute the following:*

635.13. Add the following:

Install temporary pavement markings for the centerline. Do not install temporary pavement markings for the edgelines. If temporary raised pavement markers are used, install per Detail E635-A.



NOTES:

1. For periods as noted in Table A, pavement may be unmarked if appropriate vehicle positioning guides are provided.
2. Typical spacing between Vehicle Position Guides is 40 ft as shown. In areas of severe curvature the spacing is 20 ft. Areas of severe curvature are shown in the plans or provided in the Vehicle Positioning Guide Schedule.
3. See Section 718.21(b) requirements for vehicle positioning guides.
4. When ADT > 1000 and special hazards are present, supplement the R4-1 sign at the beginning of each no passing zone with a W14-3 sign mounted on the left of the roadside.
5. Repeat R4-1 at 3,000 ft intervals minimum.
6. Signs required for use under this Detail will not be measured separately, but will be considered part of the Traffic Control Lump Sum Pay Item work.
