Videotaping - While it is not required, we highly recommend that you videotape the entire project for your use during the estimating phase.

Location/Type of work - This project begins at the Bumble Bee Road (also known as FH 209) intersection and extends 12.9 miles east to the bridge crossing the Couer d'Alene River near Pritchard. The project consists of 12.9 miles of subexcavation, base, and paving. It was designed using U.S. Customary measurement and references the *Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects, FP-03*.
