The attached preliminary plans are being furnished to aid prospective bidders in identifying the location and type of work for this project. The project will be advertised during a period when viewing of the project is not possible due to snow. Therefore, prospective bidders are encouraged to view the project during the fall as conditions permit. No Federal Highway Administration personnel will be available for show-me tours.

While it is not required, we highly recommend that you videotape the entire project for your use during the estimating phase. We have received good feedback from contractors who have done this in the past.

This project begins at approximately milepost 10.50 on State Route 123 and continues north, approximately to the intersection of State Route 123 and State Route 410 (Cayuse Pass) Project work then continues east on State Route 410 for approximately 1.2 miles, milepost 67.0. Work also includes pedestrian improvements at the Tipsoo Lake View Point area adjacent to State Route 410 at approximately milepost 68.8. State Route 123 is located approximately 8 miles north of Packwood, in Pierce County, Washington. The project consists of subexcavation, grading, drainage, base, paving, and structures. It was designed using customary measurement and references the *Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects, FP-03, US Customary Units*.
