The attached preliminary plans are being furnished to aid prospective bidders in identifying the location and type of work for this project. The project will be advertised during a period when viewing of the project is not possible due to snow. Therefore, prospective bidders are encouraged to view the project during the fall as conditions permit. No Federal Highway Administration personnel will be available for show-me tours.

The Denali Park Road in Denali National Park is open to public travel from Monday through Sunday until the snow falls, approximately late October. If you have any questions concerning access into the park call Tim Taylor, East District Roads Supervisor, at 907-683-9558.

While it is not required, we highly recommend that you videotape the entire project for your use during the estimating phase. We have received good feedback from contractors who have done this in the past.

This project begins at approximately milepost 4.0 and continues for 0.9 miles on the Denali Park Road. Denali National Park is located in Denali Borough, in the State of Alaska. The project consists of grading, base, paving, and drainage. It was designed using U.S. Customary measurement and references the *Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects, FP-03, US Customary Units*
