

Responses to the Questions Received
Renovation of Men's Dormitory and Design and Construction of Dining Facility

1. In A(6) Egress:
They mentioned that the double –swing doors in corridors and halls are 36 but those are 48 Doors excluding main Door.

Answer: All doors need to meet NFPA 101, Life Safety Code (2006) standards for existing hotels and dormitories. Contractor shall determine which doors are covered under the NFPA standard and propose appropriate rectification or replacement.

2. A (4) Plumbing:
They mentioned that wall tiles it mean including all partition and other wall from bottom to top in bathroom also in kitchen

Answer: Wall tiles should be provided “as appropriate” in the kitchen and bathrooms. This is a contractor decision and should be reflected in the proposal

3. A (10) Furnishings:
They mentioned that in one room 8 student for each (bed, pillow, mattress, blanket, table and chair) there are two kind of rooms small room 64 and big room 192, for
 $192 \times 8 = 1536$ students
 $64 \times 2 = 128$ students
Also floor furnishing is not clear which kind (carpet, plastic...)
In addition cupboards for students are not understandable are this is like existing we will make Partition in big room in this partition we should make cupboard or separate they want.

Answer: Carpets. As stated in the RFP, “Durable and functional, long-life and commercial quality...” (Plastic floor covering is neither durable nor commercial quality – contractor needs to put down what he/she thinks meets this standard).

4. A (12)
Temporary Student housing:
In temporary student housing we should prepare new ((bed, pillow, mattress, blanket, table and chair) or they should use existing tools.

Answer: The same bedroom specifications for furnishings in the main dormitory, i.e. bed, pillow, mattress, etc. shall apply to the Temporary Student Housing (Fine Art Building) for 400 students
