The type of contract should be an indefinite quality task order contract for the competitive 8(a) bidding process.</p> <p>One of the provisions of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) requires new passenger vehicles to be labeled with safety rating information published by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's New Car Assessment Program (NCAP). NCAP is required to put safety rating information on the label mandated by the Automobile Information Disclosure Act (the Monroney lable or price sticker). Timely testing of the vehicles upon their production and providing accurate engineering data analysis promptly are essential to the success of the program as intended by Congress. Since the new model year production coincides with the the end of the fiscal year, it is imperative that quality control and data analysis of testing results be done in time. In addition, as part of a consumer information program, NCAP must evaluate the Ease-of-Use (EOU) child restraint system program, publish Buying a Safer Car and Buying a Safer Car for Child Passenger brochures, and conduct special investigations in support of rulemaking and the NCAP information program.</p> <p>Period of Performance: Two year Base with One(Three Year) Option Period.
