NOTICE TO POTENTIAL OFFERORS:

- During the Pre-Proposal Conference, information was provided that the Government would entertain a request to provide an opportunity for offerors to submit an Executive Summary before the due date of proposals for evaluation of the selected Parent Craft. However, after careful consideration of the request made at the PPC, the Government has determined that it will be unable to facilitate an early evaluation. Offerors are encouraged to utilize criteria in the RFP to ensure their parent craft meets the specified requirements.
- The information provided in the Pre-Proposal Conference (PPC) Minutes with regards to filtering questions on the FRC-B project website to locate questions posed at the PPC is incorrect. Offerors can access most questions provided during the PPC on the project website by filtering on "Comment Date: 7/27/2007". Please note that non-proprietary questions received via the website and at the PPC are posted to the project website in the order in which they are answered.
- The following clarifies inconsistencies of key acquisition schedule milestones and dates provided in the Request For Proposal (RFP) Cover Letter:

- Potential Offerors are encouraged to adhere to the information provided in the RFP, associated specification documents and attachments as these remain the precedent terms and conditions of the RFP. If the RFP requires changes, an amendment to the RFP will be issued appropriately.
