Photos and preliminary plans are being furnished to aid prospective bidders in identifying the location and type of work for this project. No Federal Highway Administration personnel will be available for show-me tours.

There is no special access required for the project although there is private property along the roadside. Do not trespass on private property unless granted access by the property owner.

This project is located approximately 5.4 km (3.3 miles) east of Cascade, Idaho on Forest Highway 22. The project is 21.565 km (13.40 miles) long and begins approximately at the intersection of Forest Highway 22 and private road Joshua Dr and ends approximately 0.1 miles before reaching Big Creek Summit.

Major construction items include subexcavation, cold in place recycle asphalt base, drainage and asphalt concrete paving. It was designed using metric measurement and references the *Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects, FP-03, Metric Customary Units*
